<u>**Phonics</u>** – Pupils will continue to follow the Read Write Inc scheme for phonics and will practise reading independently within all daily phonics lessons. They will be grouped according to their stage on the programme and will learn to read, write and spell words that contain the focus sounds. Pupils will also continue to build upon their knowledge of everyday 'red words' which cannot be decoded as they do not follow a specific phonic</u>

## Communication and Language

Children will practise the skills of learning to wait to share their ideas. They will be encouraged to articulate their thoughts and ideas in well-formed sentences, connecting one idea to another using a range of connectives. They will hold conversations with peers and adults, using key vocabulary, throughout the day. Children will listen to a range of stories, songs and rhymes and will make comments about what they have heard.
