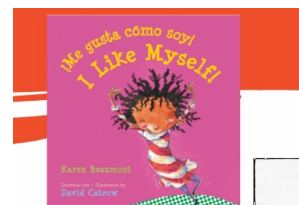

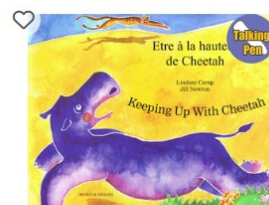

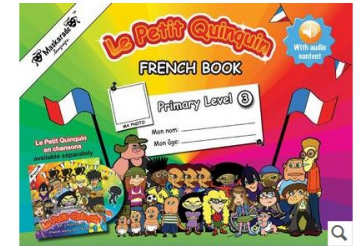


Ways to Learn a Different Language

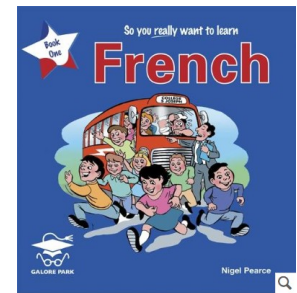
- Set your language goals
- Learn common vocabulary that you would use in your everyday conversations
- Find a style that works for you—Flashcards, grammar translations, spaced repetition
 - Practice speaking
 - Connect with a native speaker
 - Consume media
 - Engage with the culture
 - Make travel plans
- Do a mix of reading, writing, listening and speaking activities
 - Read a dual language book
- Identify cognates (a word in that language that is similar to the one)
Example: un train—a train (French)
atención—attention (Spanish)
