## **School Attendance**

You may have read in the news that school attendance has not recovered to normal levels following the Covid pandemic. This is a trend that we are experiencing at Wavendon Gate School. Whilst most of our children attend school regularly, and I thank parents for their efforts, we have seen an increase in parents removing their children from school to take term-time holidays. So far this academic year, we have issued Fixed Penalty Notices to the families of 31 children; 179 school days have been missed due to children taking term-time holidays. This has a direct impact on children's learning as well as disturbing other children's education when the child returns and needs to catch up. In addition to this, pupils who are frequently absent from school may feel less connected to their classmates and school which is detrimental to their academic and social and emotional development.

I am also aware of many families taking children out of school for holidays but for only 4 days so to avoid the fines. Please can I remind you that if a child's attendance drops below 90% then parents can still be prosecuted.

From August 2024, the fine for school absences across the country will be  $\pounds$ 80 if paid within 21 days, or  $\pounds$ 160 if paid within 28 days. In the case of repeated fines, if a parent receives a second fine for the same child within any three-year period, this will be charged at the higher rate of  $\pounds$ 160. Fines per parent will be capped to two fines within any three-year period. Once this limit has been reached, other actions like a parenting order or prosecution will be considered.
