

<u>Crigiisri</u>
This half term, children will develop their composition,
grammar and spelling knowledge through both fiction
and non-fiction writing. We will read books by Lauren
Child and use these as a stimulus for fiction writing.
The children will write an information text all about
castles. They will secure their knowledge of
subordination and coordination, writing consistently in
the correct tense and ensuring all sentences include
the appropriate punctuation. Throughout the half
term, children will continue to practise handwriting to
ensure all letters are formed correctly and develop
understanding of how to join some letters together.

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<u>Maths</u>

In maths this half term, children will consolidate their learning of year 2 maths. This continued practise will help to build confidence and fluency with place value and the arithmetic methods: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and fractions. The children will also be securing their understanding of how to apply these methods to one and two-step word problems. We will revise the measure units including time, money, length and mass. We will continue to build confidence with geometry including properties of 2D and some 3D shapes.
