

## R&W - How do some people talk to God?

<b>communicate</b>	To share thoughts, feelings and ideas with others.
<b>mandir</b>	A Hindu temple or place of worship.
<b>mosque</b>	A special building where Muslim people go to pray and learn about their religion.
<b>murti</b>	A statue or image showing a deity.
<b>prayer</b>	Communicating with God.
<b>Qur'an</b>	Muslim scripture, believed by many Muslims to be the word of God as revealed to the Prophet Muhammad.
<b>Salah</b>	The five daily prayers carried out by some Muslims.
<b>synagogue</b>	A special place where Jewish people gather for worship, prayer and community.
<b>Torah</b>	Part of Jewish scripture which many Jewish people believe to be the word of God.
<b>Veda</b>	Ancient Hindu scriptures, filled with hymns, prayers and teachings.
