

<u>English</u> Pupils will build on their knowledge of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions including; when, if, but and because. The children will develop their descriptive vocabulary and writing when delving into the fantasy story 'The Dragon Machine' by Helen Ward. They will revisit their learning on instructions using the wonderful book 'Instructions' by Neil Gaiman. We will learn how to use apostrophes for contractions and possession. The children will then study and write their own poetry.

## <u>Maths</u>

Pupils will develop their understanding of money. They will begin to identify, count and compare coins and notes of differing amounts before moving onto calculations using money. They will apply their previous knowledge of addition and subtraction to this and extend to reasoning and word problems to deepen their understanding. We will move onto multiplication and division methods. The children will continue to develop their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables focusing on securing efficient methods and rapid recall.
